

Quick User Instructions for the Vertical SBX IP 320 system

Recording your mailbox greeting message

- Press Change VM Recording or press the Callback button
 If you press the Callback button press 2 for User greeting
- The system will say "If you want to leave a message press the # key" If you have already recorded a greeting the system will play your greeting
- If you're happy with your message hang up
- To Rerecord your message press the # key at any time
- Press the **HOLD/SAVE** key when done.

Accessing Voicemail

From your phone

• Press the Callback key.

At another phone:

- Press The Callback key
- press the # button
- enter your extension number
- enter your password and #

Outside the office

Call the office

If someone answers have them transfer directly into your mailbox. While your greeting is playing, press the *key

If the Auto Attendant answers Dial 9

- enter your extension number
- enter your password and #

You'll see on the display and hear a message telling you the number of messages

Use the **softkeys** for playing, deleting etc. Press the right arrow > navigation key to access additional options.

You can also dial:

1 Listen to messages

1 for new, 2 for Saved or 3 for urgent messages

While listening to a message dial:

- 1 = to listen to the current message again
- 2 = to listen to the next message
- **3** = to delete the current message
- 4 = to delete all received messages

2 Change mailbox greetings

- 1 Play greeting
- 2 Record a new greeting
- 3 delete greeting

3 Leave a message

Dial the extension number Press # to start recording

to enter another mailbox

Transfer a Call Directly to a Voice mailbox

While on a call

- Press the TRANS/PGM Button
- Press the CALLBACK Button
- Press the DSS(Direct Station Selector) button OR dial the station number
- Hang up

To Change your voicemail password

- TRANS/PGM and dial 32
- Enter your new password
- Press HOLD/SAVE

Call Recording

- Press the Call Recording key any time during a conversation
- Press the Call Record again key to stop recording or hang up

Calls recorded are saved as voicemail messages.

Call Transfer

While on a call:

• Press the **DSS**(Direct Station Selector) button **OR dial** the station number.

The call is put on hold while transferring

- Wait for the extension to answer and talk **OR** hang up.
- If you talk prior to transferring, the call will ring on the extension when you hang up
- You can also press the outside line key again to retrieve the call

To use Paging

- Press the Page All button if programmed or Dial 543
- Hang up or wait for paged person if using Meet Me Paging

To use Meet Me Paging

When you've been paged, press the Meet Me Page button if programmed or Dial 544

To send a ringing call to voicemail press your DSS key

To retrieve a call that has just gone to your voicemail press the outside line key for that call.

Setting up the Programmable keys

To program a button as a speed dial:

- Press TRANS/PGM
- Press the desired flex key
- press the phone number soft key on the displayDial 9 plus the phone number
- Press Hold/Save when complete

To program a button for another station's mailbox:

NOTE: This button is used to show Message Waiting status and for direct access to another mailbox

- Press TRANS/PGM
- · Press desired flex button
- Press TRANS/PGM 47 xxx where 'xxx' represents the target mailbox number
- Press Hold/Save when complete

Attendant Functions Station 100 only

To set the ringing Mode

- press FWD/DND
- Dial the MODE number
 - 1 Day, 2 Night, 3 On Demand, 4 Weekend, 5 Automatic mode switching, 6 Lunch
- Press HOLD/SAVE

To record Auto Attendant system greetings

- On station **100**:
- Press TRANS/PGM dial 06
- the display should ask for a system number 001 to 100. Dial the greeting number
- Record a new greeting by pressing #
- Save the greeting by pressing the hold/save key.

Station Feature Cancel

The attendants can cancel features such as DND, Call Forward and pre-selected messages at other stations.

To disable active features at a station from the attendant station:

- Press the [TRANS/PGM] button.
- Dial 071.
- Dial the desired station range.
- Press the [HOLD/SAVE] button

System Time/Date Setting

The system must be in Programming mode. To enter programming mode

Press the [TRANS/PGM] button and dial * #. A confirmation tone will sound.

- Press the [TRANS/PGM] button.
- Dial 178.

To Change the time:

- Press Line 1. This is the top left Flex key
- enter 24 hour time
- Press the Hold Save button
- Lift and replace handset

To change the date

- Press the line 2 button. This is the second from top left Flex key
- enter the date in MMDDYY format (eg january 27, 2009=270109)
- Press the Hold Save button
- · Lift and replace handset
